<b>Learning outcomes – how did the trip/visit meet the curriculum objectives.</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children learnt about the training process of joining the Roman army. This was learnt in ‘stages’.</li> <li>• Children handled weaponry and armour that were a copy of real Roman artefacts.</li> <li>• NC History KS2- The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.</li> <li>• Children learnt how to defend themselves using shields and were taught how to use them effectively.</li> <li>• Children learnt about and acted out different tactics that the Roman army used, such as the tortoise.</li> <li>• Children learnt about how Romans sacrificed their home life for the army and the effect it had on them.</li> <li>• Children refreshed their learning on Boudica and how she fought the Romans.</li> </ul>
