This was learnt in ‘stages’.• Children handled weaponry and armour that were a copy of real Roman artefacts.• NC History KS2- The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.• Children learnt how to defend themselves using shields and were taught how to use them effectively.• Children learnt about and acted out different tactics that the Roman army used, such as the tortoise.• Children learnt about how Romans sacrificed their home life for the army and the effect it had on them.• Children refreshed their learning on Boudica and how she fought the Romans.
