Learning outcomes - how did the trip/visit meet the curriculum objectives.	<p>National Curriculum KS2 History: 'develop chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of British history.'</p> <p>The children would have the opportunity to explore the Gaol House and the courtrooms of the Lynn Town Hall. The children would be able to consolidate their learning of the Crime and Punishment topic, understand trials, witch trials and the Gaol of our town.</p>
